4 steps to follow:

- Log into My Interreg Europe
- 2. Publish short description of your idea
- 3. Add required details on your project idea
 - Not published; for joint secretariat use only
 - Submit advanced project idea (with first partners and policy instruments identified)
- 4. Request feedback on your project idea


