MEDEF AURA also created Le Local, the first accelerator dedicated to supporting companies committed to the territory: https://accelerateur-lelocal.fr/. Le Local offers a variety of services aimed at supporting the development and transformation of young companies. It focuses on accelerating business models through economic, social, and environmental performance. The services include courses based on a dual education system, with professional and continuous training programs for adults, particularly in areas such as digital marketing, e-business, and digital data management. The accelerator provides individual and collective support, supervised by a dedicated coordinator and professionals mobilizable at all stages of business development. Participants benefit from expertise workshops and feedback from entrepreneurs, promoting the consolidation and transformation of businesses for better overall performance.

In summary, IPRA MEDEF AURA will be able to propose 3 types of actions within European projects: Awareness-raising, animation, Advisory to enterprises, Vocational training
