About the „MUKMAV“



- The funding programme for sustainable mobility (NMOB)








Topics addressed by the „MUKMAV“



The existing policy instruments and strategies in the field of sustainable mobility in Saarland are to be further developed with regard to the aspect of intermodality. On the one hand, a strategy for the implementation of Car-Sharing and its intermodal linking with public transport will be developed. This also includes incentivising ridesharing in commuter traffic, for example by promoting a commuter platform and their integration into a regional MaaS app. Furthermore, it will be analysed to what level the existing policy instruments on intermodality are compatible with the aspect of accessibility. The aim is to develop measures that strengthen accessibility in an intermodal mobility system.

Topics addressed by the partner



In the joint project, you can address all topics that will help to face the challenge of intermodal linking of transport modes. Four central fields of action have already been identified and possible topics assigned to each. The fields of action as well as the topics can be adapted or expanded according to the requirements of the partners.
